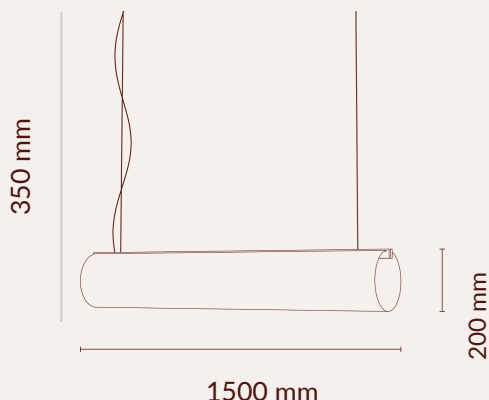

ENSO 150 pendant lamp

ENSO's circular frame in solid oak is paired with soft washi paper, forming a pendant lamp that radiates calm and continuity. Named after the Japanese symbol of the circle, gravity forms the shape over time.

General description:

Solid oak frame in three finishes (natural, smoked and black oil) with a shade in Japanese PVC-coated washi paper with magnetic joinery. First installed as a nearly perfect form, it slowly settles into its final oval shape - never quite perfect, and never quite the same.

Number of light sources: 1 integrated solid LED (light source can be replaced)

Max power consumption: Output of 2000 Lumen, 2700 Kelvin. 20W usage, RA >90

Cord: Black PVC cord of 4 meters with adjustable black steel wire of 3.5 meters

Canopy: Included, length 22.85 cm, width 5.5 cm, height 4.5 cm, black lacquered metal

IP: IP20

Class: II

Input voltage: 220-240V.

Dimming & lighting control: Rectangular black metal canopy for the dimmer. The driver is compatible with push, trailing edge and leading edge. Upon request, compatible with DALI, Casambi, and equivalent. *Made in Denmark, CE*



Cleaning and care

Gently remove dust with a dry soft cloth or a vacuum cleaner with a soft brush. For deeper cleaning, the shade can be opened and wiped carefully with a soft cloth wrung in lukewarm water.
